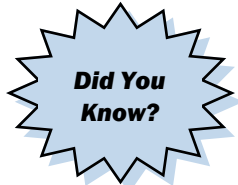

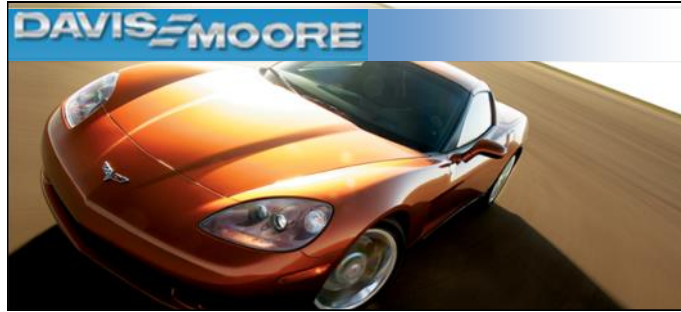

## Midway USA Chapter All Corvette Car Show

Midway USA Chapter's All Corvette Car Show was held June 17th at Davis-Moore Chevrolet. This is the 2nd year in a row that we had to postpone the show due to rain. Unfortunately, the morning of the 17th also started with rain, which delayed participants from arriving at 9:00. But, the forecast and radar showed the rain would end by around 8:45 and would be gone for the rest of the morning and most of the afternoon. Participants were slow to arrive, but as soon as the rain was over, more cars showed up. Considering the weather, we ended up with 55 registered Corvettes representing all 8 generations. Judging of the cars started about 10:15 am by 4 volunteer judges, a representative for our charity, The American Cancer Society, and a representative of Davis-Moore. O'Reilly's (Tyler & Central) manager, Erin, furnished the pulled pork sandwiches and sides that we sold with the profits going to our charity. Door prizes were given out throughout the show. We had 3 car care buckets and a metal EXIT sign that we raffled off with the proceeds also going to AMC. A 50/50 pot was split between the winner and AMC. Overall, the car show was a success, despite the rainy start. Wind was light, and the temperature was in the mid 80s by the end of the show. We raised in excess of \$1,700 for the American Cancer Society.

Thanks to all members that helped set up, run registration, serve food, sell 50/50 pot and raffle tickets, and then tear down.

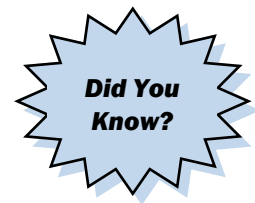

Food? Well, what can I say? Nebraska knows how to take care of our guests, and we are working on some great new menus for this year!

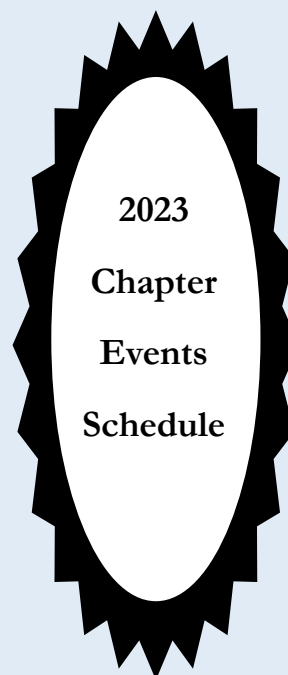
